Subject: Proposal for an Expanded Bilateral Cooperation and a Memorandum of Understanding between the Superior Council of Magistracy of the Republic of Moldova and the Judicial Council of the Slovak Republic

Following the discussions held during the recent meeting of the European Network of Judicial Councils, the Superior Council of Magistracy of the Republic of Moldova wishes to formally express its strong interest in establishing a solid and mutually beneficial framework of cooperation with the Judicial Council of the Slovak Republic.

We consider that the signing of this Memorandum of Understanding would represent an important step in strengthening our bilateral cooperation and supporting the ongoing reforms in the justice sector of the Republic of Moldova, in the context of Moldova's accession to the European Union. The Republic of Moldova remains firmly dedicated to comprehensive judicial reform and the continuous strengthening of its judiciary. Such a partnership would undoubtedly make a significant contribution to the ongoing efforts to enhance the capacity and resilience of the Moldovan judiciary.

We have the honour to propose the initiation of discussions at a time of your convenience, in order to explore possible modalities of cooperation and to work towards the drafting of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Superior Council of Magistracy of the Republic of Moldova and the Judicial Council of the Slovak Republic.
